

# Learning About God's Covenants

## **SCAVENGER HUNT**

Our Scavenger Hunt on God's Covenants is an activity for the whole family to learn more about our amazing God! A covenant is deeper than a promise. A covenant is a representation of God's lasting commitment to His people. In the Bible, the Lord establishes six covenants with His people, restoring their hope and reminding them of His faithfulness.

All together or racing on teams, family members can have fun searching for groups of items around the house that symbolize each of the six covenants.

Find all of the items below and place them in their groups:

**Adam and Eve:** Apple/fruit, clothes, snake, and a plant

**Noah:** Rainboots, umbrella, boat, and find two of the same animal

**Abraham:** Baby, star, lamb, and a family picture

**Moses:** Stone, sandals, milk, and honey

**David:** Crown, wrist band, musical instrument, and something gold

**Jesus:** Cross, hammer, heart, and water

After completing the Scavenger Hunt, share with your family, "Each of these groups represent a covenant that God made that was fulfilled in Jesus Christ and the Church. No matter what we do or how we mess up, God will always stay faithful to us and His promises!"
